It is a newly implemented form of a situational judgement test that is used by medical and dental schools. A situational judgement test is a psychological test that presents test-takers with realistic, hypothetical scenarios and assesses how an individual will behave accordingly.

\$10 per school test fee

- Assesses how an individual will behave in certain situations
- Measures 12 nonacademic skill sets

### How long are scores valid?

- Optional 15 minute break at halfway point
- Three questions after each scenario with five minutes to respond

- Each section is reviewed by a different rater (12 raters total)
- Made available to programs on your distribution list three weeks after testing
- Check CASPer account for score distributions update under 'Past Tests' section
